## **HOW TO CREATE A FACEBOOK PAGE** (I have been asked so here it is)

If you are not on Facebook and would like to know how, follow these simple instructions.

### **Step 1**

Open an Internet browser on your computer and navigate to the Facebook Sign Up Web page.

### **Step 2**

Enter your real first and last name, your email address and a password. Select your sex and birthday from the pop-up menus. Click the "Sign Up" button at the bottom of the screen.

### **Step 3**

Type the "Captcha" security code into the box provided.

### **Step 4**

You are presented with opportunities to find existing friends on Facebook. If you give the site permission, it compares your contact list to the names of people already on Facebook. You can skip this step for now, if you like.

### **Step 5**

Enter information for your profile. For now, enter just the basics. You can go back later and expand on your profile information.

### **Step 6**

Upload a profile picture when prompted. This should be an actual photograph of you, which helps friends find and identify you on the site.

### **Step 7**

Check your email. Facebook sends a confirmation email to the email address you listed on the Sign-Up page. Confirm the account as requested. You have created a Facebook account.

## **HOW DO I JOIN THE KDGC WEBSITE PAGE?**

In these uncertain times, we encourage you to sign up to Facebook so you can keep up to date with Club activities and announcements. Of course, we understand that some of you don't want to for your own personal reasons or you do not have the technical infrastructure to do so. I know some people who sign up to Facebook but only join groups of interest without putting anything up on their personal timeline. Perhaps you might like to consider this for the time being and delete your Facebook page when its all over, if that is your preference.

If you are already on Facebook but don't know how to join the KDGC page, the instructions are below.



- Tap the looking glass on your Facebook page and then tap the search bar.
- Enter Karana Downs Garden Club.
- Tap the group name in the results and tap Join Group.
- A group admin person will receive your request and approve your request.

## **OTHER CLUB BUSINESS**

**2020 Membership Fees** are due by the end of April. You will receive a letter from our Secretary shortly should your fees not be up to date. EFT is now available, details of which will be in the letter. Should you be resigning your membership, please do let us know by ticking the appropriate box on the letter and returning it to our Secretary, Lesley Holt.

Regarding the **April bus trip** which has been postponed rather than cancelled, we are now unable to offer a refund due to the 'stay at home' rule. All payments require two signatures on the bank account, whether by cheque or electronic funds transfer. Please be assured that should the bus trip not go ahead later this year; you will be refunded any money you have paid. Thank you for your understanding in this regard.

On that note, the Management Committee approved the acquisition of two **tokens from Heritage Bank** to be issued against the Treasurer and the President roles. These tokens enable the **secure** multi-factor authentication payment of on-line transactions. Once these tokens have been approved by the Bank, we will be able to do refunds, make payments etc without having to be together in the one place. It is proposed that by the end of 2020 we will no longer be issuing cheques.

The **grant application** with Heritage Bank has been submitted. Should we be successful and depending on the amount granted, it is the Committee's intention to upgrade the KDGC website to a cloud-based platform. Should we not be successful with Heritage Bank or the grant amount is insufficient, grants from other organisations will be sought. It is anticipated that in the future, the KDGC webpage will be the resource we rely on for updating members on all our activities.

The Management Committee approved the redirection of the **Club's mail** to the Secretary's address for a period of 6 months. This is in keeping with the 'stay at

home' rule and a more permanent arrangement will be discussed at the May Management Committee Meeting.

On return to our usual meeting format, **electronic funds transfer** will be available for your convenience. This does not apply to the \$3 entry fee or the raffles and plant stall areas, however it will apply to membership, bus trips, carpools etc.

**The Melbourne Cup** will be here before we know it. We are asking for two volunteers willing to run the sweep. A hand over will be provided by our previous long-term volunteers, Anne and Peter. If you think you could do this, please email and expression of interest to Sue Dwan. 😊

Sue and her team are conjuring up something a bit different this year, so watch this space for a future update.

### **ARCHIVIST WANTED**

We are looking for a member who would be interested in archiving our history from the past 30 years. There are a lot of documents in a lot of different members' homes. The Management Committee has approved the purchase of a scanner suitable to the task. It is a longer-term project with no real time limit. The goal is to preserve our history for the future.
